Notice of Job Vacancy Water Systems Maintenance Craftsman

Performs skilled manual work in the construction, operation and maintenance of either water and/or sewer systems, including work on reservoir water gates, sewers, side sewers, drains, mains and connectors.

Examples of work:

- Lays and connects service pipes.
- Locates and repairs water or sewer leaks.
- Installs fire hydrants.
- Operates water gates.
- Turns on water for new service.
- Incidentally, may supervise a small crew of workers at a lower skill level, such as laborers and maintenance workers.
- Subject to emergency recall as required.

Qualifications:

- Must possess a MA Certification Grade 2 Operation Drinking Water Supply Facility License (D-2) as required by the Department of Environmental Protection Regulations.
- Must possess a CDL Class B License.
- Knowledge of construction and function of water meters.
- Knowledge of practices, materials, tools and equipment used in maintenance and construction work in connection with municipal water systems.
- Ability to read all types of water meters and meter dials.
- Ability to write legibly (both words and figures).
- Must be available for emergencies and snow removal.

Starting salary is \$20.50/hour. This is a full-time position, 40-hours per week. Hours of work are 7:00am - 3:30pm, Monday through Friday.
