



Summer Water Laborer

The Littleton Water Department will be hiring a summer laborer to assist licensed water operators with the routine operation & maintenance of water system infrastructure. Depending on the applicant's abilities and interests, this may include assisting with the maintenance & operation of specialized equipment (after receiving training), as well as independently conducting non-specialized maintenance activities. Potential duties include painting of fire hydrants, water quality sampling and laboratory analysis, assisting with the maintenance and repair of water treatment equipment and instrumentation, assisting with water service repairs, and GIS mapping of water infrastructure.

The position requires a valid Class D Massachusetts Driver's license, the ability to pass a pre-employment drug screen and physical, and a genuine interest in learning about water utility operations. The position is for 40 hours per week, 6:30 – 4:30, Monday through Thursday. Dates of employment are flexible but anticipated to be up to 12 weeks between late May and late August. Pay rate is \$20 per hour.
