**Water Division Manager**

The Wrentham Water Department is seeking a full time, skilled individual to work as the Primary Operator of a Massachusetts Drinking Water Supply Facility. Responsible for the management, operation and maintenance of the Town's water supply, treatment storage and distribution system. Directs the day-to-day operation of the Water Division, which involves planning, developing, overseeing and inspecting of new construction. Supervises the routine and emergency repair and maintenance of the water supply, distribution and treatment facilities.

Must be a certified operator of a Massachusetts Drinking Water Supply Facility and must possess the proper grade licenses, along with a valid CDL and a hoisting license from the Massachusetts Department of Public Safety. Must have a high school diploma and six (6) years of water supply and distribution related experience with at least two years in a supervisory role. Work related education beyond high school may be substituted for some of the experience.

Must assist other departments in emergency situations, such as snow and ice events.

Will be required to be on-call after hours, weekends and holidays, on a rotating schedule.

Starting wage depends on licenses and experience. This is a Union position.
