- Generally, perform all aspects of municipal and private water system work.
- Perform evaluations and maintenance on fire hydrants and PIVs; complete related reports
- Perform leak detection; complete related reports
- Perform hydrant flushing programs and complete related reports
- General garage maintenance such as sweeping, cleaning, vehicle washing/maintenance
- Respond to emergency service/repair calls outside of normal working hours including evening, weekends and holidays regardless of weather conditions
- Installs and repair water lines and valves; installs and remove fire hydrants; perform wet taps
- Map and diagram water locations; log jobs completed
- Dig holes, pour concrete; lay pipe; clear vegetation

Requirements:

- Valid, unrestricted driver's license, including a 'good' driving record, CDL license a plus
- High school diploma or GED
- OSHA-10 card or greater
- Hoisting License (1B) preferred, but individual attainment within 3 months of hire required
- Hydraulic License (2A) preferred but not required
- Water industry experience/licenses a plus, training available for right candidate
- Must pass pre-employment physical and drug/alcohol testing
- Must pass complete background and criminal check
- Occasional overnight travel may be required
- Sit, stand and walk for long periods of time, lift up to 100 pounds, be able to reach, handle and manipulate objects, stoop, squat, kneel etc. as well as good eyesight and hearing required (naturally or with correction)
- Ability to respond to emergencies, cover on call responsibilities and work overtime on a regular basis (greater than 40 hours per week) are essential.
