The Hadley Department of Public Works, Water Division is accepting applications for a permanent full time Water Division employee. Position consists of a variety of semi-skilled and skilled technical and maintenance work. Duties for this position include maintenance of records, performing water tests, assisting in the operating of the water Treatment Plant, maintaining water quality, maintaining buildings and grounds, meter reading and repair and installation of water system components. Assists both the Primary Water Treatment Operator and the Primary Water Distribution Operator. Most work is performed in the field with exposure to all types of weather. The candidate will be called for emergency water breaks and perform physical labor under adverse conditions and will assist the Highway Division in snow plowing if needed. Rotates weekend treatment plant overtime coverage with other treatment operators. Applicants must possess or be able to obtain within 6 months, a valid Massachusetts D1 operator license and a valid Massachusetts T1 operator license. Must also possess or be able to obtain a MA Hoisters license and a Commercial Driver's License. The pay scale is \$17.95 to \$23.64 per hour. The successful candidate must pass a pre-employment physical examination and drug test and be subject to a six (6) month probationary period.
