Secondary Water Treatment Operator

The Secondary Water Treatment Plant Operator is responsible for the proper operation of water well and treatment facilities and the wastewater pumping facilities. These facilities include the pumping units, the wells, the aerators, the filtration tanks, the comminutors, the chemical feed systems, and the disinfection systems. The incumbent is also responsible for the following: testing the water characteristics to accurately maintain the proper dosages of applied chemicals, keeping accurate and complete records of the water and wastewater pumping and treatment process operations and assisting in the maintenance of process equipment. The incumbent performs other related assignments as required, including grounds maintenance and the plowing of snow.

Requirements: Possession of a valid Massachusetts Drinking Water Supply Operator Certification of Grade 1 Treatment. Education and experience requirements are determined by the Board of Certification of Operators of Drinking Water Supply Facilities and are outlined on the Education and Experience Requirements Worksheet for Operator Grade and Status. Basic knowledge of personal computers, SCADA systems, electricity, and effective oral communications skills. Possession of a valid Massachusetts Driver's License Class D and the ability to operate motor equipment.
