MASSACHUSETTS WATER WORKS ASSOCIATION PATRICK O'NEALE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

This award was established in 2021 in memory of MWWA's Past President Patrick S. O'Neale, PE. Up to \$2,000 in scholarship awards will be presented each year to undergraduate student(s) pursuing a degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering at a 4-year college or university, with preference given to those candidates whose programs of study are related to water works practice

The Scholarship Committee will select recipients from applicants who meet the following eligibility requirement:

- *Applicant is pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil or Environmental Engineering at an accredited academic institution in the United States*

The Scholarship Committee will score applicants on the following criteria:

- *Applicants who have a specialized interest in pursuing a career related to water works practice will be scored higher than general Civil or Environmental Engineering students*
- *GPA*
- *Volunteerism in School/Community*
- *Content of Essay*

The applicant cannot be a prior recipient of the scholarship.

The foregoing may be amended at any time by the Board of Directors at a duly called meeting by a majority vote of those present and voting. MWWA reserves the right to not award any scholarship for any year in which outstanding candidates are not identified.
