NAME OF THE COMMITTEE: Education Committee

PURPOSE: Development of educational courses and seminars for operators and other water works professionals.

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE:

- Staffed by MWWA Training Coordinator
- Co-Chairs
- Members

MEETING SCHEDULE: Monthly Meetings on the 2nd Friday of the month. Meetings alternating between virtual and in-person (locations TBD).

GENERAL TIME COMMITMENT: 3 hours for the monthly meeting, plus the occasional ½ hour for such things as: review paperwork before meeting, making connections to help facilitate courses. Encouraged to attend Membership Meetings and Annual Planning Session. Co-Chairs can anticipate an additional 15-20 hours per year.

COMMITTEE TASKS/DELIVERABLES DURING A YEAR:

- Development and review of the Committee Annual Work Plan
- Identify educational needs of those in the industry
- Review course evaluations
- Suggest course topics/locations/speakers
- Review policy/regulations/news from the Board of Certification
- Monitoring of prerequisite courses
- Nominate Harold Fletcher Award

- Help with registration at the Summer Expo training session
- Help with courses (outline, network for instructors)

- Nominate an individual for the Harold Fletcher Award
- Review committee policies as needed
- New committee member recruitment

CHAIR(S) RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Facilitate monthly meetings
- Encourage participation from new members
- Foster participatory environment in Committee and at MWWA events
- Liaison between Committee and Board of Directors
