#### From Boston/ Mass Pike and points east (Directions are to the Williams Inn):

Follow Route 2 West all the way to Williamstown. The Williams Inn is on the right of the Village Green at northerly junction of Routes 7 and 2.

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike West (I- 90) to Exit 2, (Lee/Lenox). Follow Route 20 West to Route 7 North. Continue on Route 7 North through Pittsfield, Lanesboro, New Ashford and into Williamstown. The Williams Inn is on the left of the Village Green at northerly junction of Routes 7 and 2.

Take the Massachusetts Turnpike West (I-90) to (I-91) North and (I-91) North to Route 2 West. Route 2 West to Williamstown. As you follow Route 2 through Williamstown the Williams Inn is on the right of the Village Green at northerly junction of Routes 7 and 2
