This course reintroduces the topics covered within the initial 8-hour certification; certification must be renewed every 5 years. This class will provide an understanding of:

- Types and uses of asbestos and identification of the material
- The nature of asbestos-related diseases and routes of exposure
- Review of applicable federal and state regulations regarding asbestos.
- Review of the updates made to MassDEP's AC Pipe Guidance Document
- Proper AC Pipe Work Practices including final visual inspection and waste disposal procedures and related reporting forms

Attendees must successfully pass a multiple choice exam to receive certification. Those completing this seminar will be awarded **3.0 TCHs**. Credits approved for both water and wastewater operators
