Handling and Disposal of AC Pipe – Framingham Case Study

While many water utilities are aware of MassDEP's requirements for the proper handling and disposal of Asbestos Cement Pipe (ACP), there are still many that have not implemented the proper procedures.

At this year's Summer Expo at Mount Wachusett (August 22, 2019) the City of Framingham will explain how they overcame the many challenges of dealing with the proper notification, management, handling and storage of AC Pipe and AC Pipe containing material. The session is approved for 2 Training Contact Hours (TCHs) and will also include a brief overview of the health effects of asbestos and the highlights of the Massachusetts asbestos pipe regulation that have been in place since 2011.
