FROM ROUTE 3:

Take Route 3 South to the Sagamore Bridge rotary. Bear right on Route 6 without going over the bridge to East Buzzards Bay rotary. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around the rotary and bear right on Main St. to first set of traffic lights. Turn left, you are now on Academy Drive. The fair will be located in Admiral's Hall in the Harrington Building.

FROM ROUTE 495:

Take Route 495 South to Cape Cod exit (Rte. 25). Follow Route 25 to Route 6 & 28 to West Buzzards Bay Rotary. Go straight to traffic lights. Turn right, you are now on Academy Drive. The fair will be located in Admiral's Hall in the Harrington Building.
