Hydrants are the most visible component of a water system. They are used to fight fires, flush pipelines and occasionally used to supply water to trucks or other construction equipment. Improper installation, repair or maintenance can lead to inadequate flow or failure which may result in a life-threatening situation when fighting a fire.

This class will provide an overview of the common types of hydrants and how to properly install, operate, repair, and maintain this critical distribution system component. The training will include a hands-on portion. An overview of new hydrant technologies as well as performing hydrant flushing and flow testing will also be presented.
