Take Rt. 290 East to exit 19 (which is 190 North).

Take Exit 5 off 190 North, which will put you onto 140 North. Follow 140 North for nine miles to the access road on the left.

#### From Boston (1 hour)

Take Rt. 2 West to Exit 25 for Westminster/Princeton. Take Rt. 140 South to our access road on the right.

# From Providence (1 1/4 hours)

Take Rt. 146 North to Rt. 290 East to Rt. 190 North. Take Exit 5 Rt. 140 North nine miles to the access road on the left.

# From Hartford, Ct. (1 1/2 hours)
