# **DIRECTIONS TO WACHUSETT MOUNTAIN SKI AREA**

Wachusett Mountain Ski Area is easily accessible from Route 140 in Westminster. There is excellent signage to guide you from Route 140 to the Mountain. For GPS Use this address: 41 Mile Hill Road, Westminster, MA 01473 From Worcester (20 minutes) Take Rt. 290 East to exit 19 (which is 190 North). Take Exit 5 off 190 North, which will put you onto 140 North. Follow 140 North for nine miles to the access road on the left. From Boston (1 hour) Take Rt. 2 West to Exit 25 for Westminster/Princeton. Take Rt. 140 South to our access road on the right. From Providence (1 1/4 hours) Take Rt. 146 North to Rt. 290 East to Rt. 190 North. Take Exit 5 Rt. 140 North nine miles to the access road on the left. From Hartford, Ct. (1 1/2 hours) Take Rt. 84 East to the Mass Pike East to Exit 10 Auburn to Rt. 290 East to Rt. 190 North to Exit 5 Rt. 140 North nine miles to the access road on the left. From Nashua, N.H. (1 1/4 hours) Take Rt. 130 West to Rt. 13 South to Rt. 2A West to Rt. 140 South or Rt. 3 South to Rt. 495 South to Rt. 2 West Exit 25 Rt. 140 South to access road on the right.
