

## Centrifugal Pumps – Understanding Their Applications & Operations

MWWA Course: MWWA 21-004, Wastewater: BC-2021-3620

Centrifugal pumps are the most widely used type of pump in the water industry. While a seemingly simple device of a rotating impeller to move water, centrifugal pumps have developed into a wide range of complex configurations with amazing, automated control capabilities. This course will review the various centrifugal pump designs, their applications and critical maintenance issues. Important information about understanding pump performance curves and how they can be used to troubleshoot hydraulic performance will also be presented.

This half day course is a *must* for all new operators – both distribution and treatment. It will also serve as a valuable refresher for experienced operators.
