

<u>Lead & Copper Sampling – Do This, Not That!</u>

MWWA Course: MWWA 21-007

It has been nearly 30 years since the implementation of the Lead and Copper Rule (LCR). Some aspects of the LCR have remained the same while others have changed. New proposed changes are on the horizon. One thing that hasn't changed is the requirement to collect 1-liter samples from within residential locations. The coordination of the residential sampling, the importance of proper sample collection and the reporting requirements are the most complicated of the EPA Rules.

This half day class will provide attendees with an overview of the current rule and the proposed changes. It will also include valuable tips on coordinating residential sampling and sampling techniques as well as the proper reporting and notification requirements.

This is a valuable refresher for staff familiar with the LCR and is a **MUST** for new staff needing to understand the critical aspects of the LCR.

- Discuss tips on coordinating residential sampling and proper sampling methods.
