

Preparing for A Cross Connection Control Program Audit Remote Class Using Zoom

NEW COURSE MWWA Course: MWWA 24-007

MassDEP has recently resumed conducting audits of a Public Water System's Cross Connection Control Program (CCCP). These audits can incorporate a wide range of program components from verifying qualified personnel to documents regarding local ordinances and bylaws. This training will cover the key CCCP components that need to be tracked as well as an overview of helpful tracking tools. Tips on how to be prepared for an audit will cover everything from initial audit notification to recommendations on ways to organize all documents to help ensure that the audit goes smoothly. The training will also provide some information on new equipment and devices that have entered the industry such as trap primers, automated chemical dispensers and garbage disposals.

Learning Objectives:

- Review the components of a MassDEP CCCP audit.
- Learn about the best ways to track the CCCP program and prepare for an audit.
- Discuss new equipment and devices encountered in the field and suggested approaches for ensuring protection
