

## How to Properly Collect & Report Turbidity & CT Data In-Person Training at the Worcester WTP

MWWA Course ID: MWWA 22-008

This course is intended to provide operators of surface water supplies an understanding of the turbidity and disinfection requirements of the Surface Water Treatment Rule (SWTR). Often, water treatment plants are designed to automatically record and calculate the regulatory reporting requirements. However, not understanding the concepts can result in critical reporting errors, microbial risks to the consumers and potential violations. Proper operation and maintenance of instruments will also be covered. The Worcester WTP will be used as a case study for how the SWTR data is collected and reported.

## Learning Objectives:

- Understand the SWTR regulations and the related turbidity and CT reporting requirements.
- Learn how to ensure that instruments (flow meter, pH & chorine analyzers, turbidimeters) are operating properly.
- Tour the host water treatment facility and discuss its turbidity and CT reporting methodology.


