<u>Historical Use & Monitoring of Liquid Chlorine</u> LIVE IN-PERSON CLASS !!

It is commonly accepted that no other advancement in water treatment has had the public health impact that the use of chlorine has had. In the late 1800s and early 1900s water borne diseases such as typhoid and cholera were rampant, killing tens of thousands of people every year. In 1908 Jersey City, NJ become the first water system using chlorine. By 1918 chlorinated water was being delivered to 33 million Americans and desease rates plummeted.

This class will provide an historical overview of the use of chlorine and how it is currently used and monitored. It will cover some of the basic chemistry concepts as well as cover the regulatory requirements related to proper chlorination.


