

Confined Space Safety & Chemical Handling Safety [Live In-Person Training]

The Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) estimates that the number of injuries/fatalities in the water and wastewater industry is approximately 4.1 per 100 workers. Two hazards that are commonly encountered are entering a confined space and handling dangerous chemicals. This full day training will provide important information on how to recognize the dangers of both hazards, and what measures should be taken to ensure a safe environment for all workers. The class will be taught by Tiger Training and is approved for **6.0 TCHs** (Training Contact Hours) for both MA water and wastewater operators.

Learning Objectives:

- Review the OSHA standards for confined spaces and chemical handling
- Learn the risks associated with confined spaces and chemical handling and what precautions employees should take and the equipment that is needed.
- Discuss the common hazards and best strategies that water and wastewater operators should use when entering confined spaces and handling treatment chemicals


