WATER & SEWER SUPERINTENDENT**

Works under the general direction of the Director of Public Works, in accordance with State and local regulatory laws, rules and regulations. Administrative and supervisory work in directing the planning and operations of two municipal water treatment plants, distribution system and the wastewater collection system that transports to the MWRA system, in accordance with all applicable government regulations to promote the general health, safety and welfare of the town. Performs highly responsible functions requiring the exercise of independent judgment and technical knowledge and ability in planning, laying out the work, inspecting the work of construction projects, accounting for water recorded as entering the distribution system and its recorded consumption, and in determining the scope and scheduling of maintenance projects. Serves as the Town's representative and advisor on regulatory compliance and enforcement issues. Ensures compliance with all applicable local, State, and federal regulations for drinking water supply and wastewater discharge. Develops and monitors expenditures, revenues, and user fees of the Water and Sewer Division's operating budget and project specific budgets; supervises record-keeping

To be considered, candidates must possess a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering; five years of experience in municipal water and sewer operations in a progressively responsible capacity, including three years of supervisory experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. They should also be registered as a Massachusetts Professional Engineer or ability to acquire within six months is highly preferred and Licensed as a Massachusetts certified Grade 4 treatment and Grade 4 distribution operator or ability to acquire within six months is required. The salary range for this position is \$76,513.84 to \$94,306.50 annually.
