

Chief Water Operator

The Town of Ware seeks a Chief Water Operator for the Department of Public Works. This is a full-time, benefitted, union position. **Duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to:** perform a variety of skilled manual tasks; operate heavy and light motor equipment; conduct water sampling and treatment; perform related work as required in the operation, maintenance, repair, and supervision of repairs to town water facilities and sewer collection system; ability to perform backflow testing preferred; knowledge of SCADA and PLC systems required. Must be available for snow plowing as weather dictates.

The position requires working weekends and holidays as necessary on a regular rotation with other operators to meet staffing requirements per DEP. Working overtime when necessary for alarm calls, emergency water repairs, blocked sewer lines, and any other unforeseen situations. Possession and maintenance of a valid Massachusetts Water Operators License Grade 1 Treatment and Grade 2 Distribution required. CDL motor vehicle license and Grade 2 Treatment License preferred.

The salary and benefits for this position are established in the current agreement between the Town of Ware and Municipal Employees, United Public Service Employees Union.
