Job Summary

To work with a team in the repair, maintenance and operations of the 550,000 square feet of buildings and various facilities at The Governor's Academy including operation of the campus Grade 4 Municipal wastewater treatment plant.

Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities:

Assistant WWTP Operator

- Daily collection and laboratory analysis of WWTP process control samples.
- Perform operational and maintenance tasks in accordance with standard operating procedures.
- Additional duties as directed by the Chief Operator.
- Rotate weekend and off hour alarm coverage with Chief Operator and /or weekend operators.

Building Maintenance

- Utilizes the Academy's maintenance software program, SchoolDude to respond to and to track maintenance work requests, preventative and deferred maintenance.
- Typical building maintenance work includes interior & exterior painting, carpentry, light plumbing, light electrical, moving furniture, cleaning & housekeeping and more.
- During inclement weather, snow removal is an essential duty and sometimes involves long hours.
- Preparation for special events such as graduation and student activities may include setting up chairs & tables, tents, parking signs, traffic control, and various operational needs.
- Other duties as needed.

Qualifications and Skills Required for Position:

- Massachusetts Grade 3 Municipal Wastewater Treatment Operator License or operations experience and the ability to gain license within 3 months.
- One to three years of experience working in a specific building trade such as carpentry or painting or an equivalent facilities maintenance position.
- Computer proficiency, and the ability to learn and use the wastewater treatment plant computer control system, payroll & work order management systems.
- Able to read written work requests, understand verbal instructions, and perform multiple tasks.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Have ability to drive large trucks and operate all equipment used in the maintenance operation.
- Must have a valid driver's license and DOT medical card.
- OSHA 10 certified or the ability to obtain certification.
- Must be able to work collaboratively with a team, communicate effectively, and receive critical feedback.
- Must also be able to be self-motivated, and work independently.
- Must be able to ensure safety precautions are properly used and in place at all times.
- Must be able to work collegially; must be committed to working in a diverse community and have the ability to communicate effectively with diverse populations; must enjoy working with young people in a boarding school environment.
- Willingness to work nights and weekends when necessary, as well as provide on call coverage for the wastewater treatment plant.

Hours

- Monday – Friday, typically 07:00am to 3:30pm. Weekend/holiday wastewater treatment plant coverage when necessary 2 hr. shift between 07:00am and 10:00 am. Overtime, weekends and nights may be required.
