ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT OF SEWER & WATER

The Town of Walpole is seeking a highly qualified individual to fill the position of Assistant Superintendent of Sewer & Water. Works under the general direction of the Superintendent of Sewer & Water. Performs supervisory and technical work primarily associated with the production and treatment sections of the municipal water supply including wells, pumping stations, treatment facilities and equipment. Also performs work in similar nature as it pertains to the Town's sanitary sewer system's components and infrastructure. In the absence of the Superintendent, assumes all duties associated with both departmental functions supervisory or otherwise. Complete job description via web site www.walpole-ma.gov.

The position requires an Associate Degree with courses consisting of physical and/or biological sciences, supplemented by specialized training courses in water treatment, pumps, hydraulics and distribution. Five to seven (5-7) years' experience in a public or private treated ground water supply and sanitary sewer system, of which three years were considered as being in direct responsible charge. Any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the desirable knowledge and skills will be considered as qualifications. Must possess a valid Massachusetts Drinking Water License Grade III, D.T. (Grade IV preferable), and a Wastewater Treatment License Grade IIM-Full or the ability to obtain within six (6) months mandatory.
