The Water Department foreman is responsible for the administration of the Water Division's programs pertaining to the construction, maintenance, and operation of the Town's water system. The foreman assures that operations are carried out in accordance with federal, state and town health regulations. Responsibilities include, but not limited to, oversees the operation of drinking water treatment plant, pump stations, water main & service installations, fire hydrants, valves, meters and other water system appurtenances. Responsible for issuing assignment to the crew and ensuring those jobs are completed. Trains new employees; instructing water maintenance people on different water-related aspects of the job. The foreman works under the direction of the Superintendent.

High School diploma and 4 years' experience in the operation of a Drinking Water system
Class B CDL and Massachusetts Driver's License. Certified Massachusetts Drinking Water Supply Facilities Operator Grade T1 and D3 licenses. MA Backflow Device Tester's and Surveyor's License is desired but not necessary.
