POSITION DESCRIPTION

Duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Operates treatment facility to control flow and processing of wastewater, biosolids and effluent.
- Monitors gauges, meters and control panels.
- Operates valves and gates, either manually or by remote control; starts and stops pumps, engines and generators to control treatment processes.
- Performs laboratory duties and fills in for maintenance person when required.
- Must be able to maintain accurate records concerning process control.
- Drives a truck on as needed basis.
- Must be capable of performing rudimentary operational control functions within the facility.
- Involved with the operation and maintenance of the collection system.
- Shall be familiar with all safety equipment used in the department.
