

WATER DISTRIBUTION AND SEWER SYSTEMS OPERATOR
TOWN OF WELLESLEY - DPW

The Town of Wellesley is looking for a full time Water Distribution and Sewer Systems Operator. The incumbent participates in the Department of Public Works (DPW) programs for the inspection, installation, operation, maintenance and repair of the Town's water and sewer infrastructure by operating DPW wheel and track construction equipment. The incumbent is also responsible for supervising others on common water and sewer work assignments. This position is required to participate in the Town's snow and ice control program and must be available for stand-by, emergency and weekend duties as needed. Other requirements include a High School Diploma or equivalent; the possession of or ability to obtain a valid Massachusetts CDL Class B with air brake and tanker endorsements; the possession of or ability to obtain a valid Massachusetts Office of Public Safety and Inspection Hoisting Engineer's License classes 2A and 1C; proficiency in the operation of CDL Class B vehicles and heavy equipment; demonstrated ability to perform preventive maintenance on vehicles and equipment; the ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions and use hand and power tools; and must possess general plumbing knowledge. Pay range is \$21.57 - \$29.03 per hour.
