A recent internal personnel transfer to another one of Woodard & Curran's projects has opened up an opportunity for a Wastewater Operator at our Cohasset Wastewater Treatment Plant. This project consists of a staff of three who are responsible for the operation and maintenance of the wastewater treatment plant and collection system, including remote pump stations. In this role you will be directly involved with the overall daily operations and general maintenance of equipment at a 0.45 MGD membrane bioreactor (MBR) wastewater treatment facility. Duties will include, but not limited to, daily rounds, laboratory analysis, record keeping, process control. Sludge thickening, maintenance projects and general facility and grounds maintenance.

Our operators participate in an "on call" rotation for plant coverage outside normal workday hours and shifts may include weekends. In addition, operators will be required to respond to emergency situations and work in inclement weather as needed. The daily schedule is Monday – Friday, 7.00AM – 3.30PM.

What will you need to succeed?

- Minimum Massachusetts Grade 3 license, Massachusetts Grade 4 license preferred.
- Minimum of one year' experience in a wastewater treatment facility, operation, and maintenance; or any equivalent combination of education.
- A valid Massachusetts motor vehicle operator's license.
- Knowledge of the hazards and safety precautions involved in wastewater treatment work.
- Knowledge of computer applications, and ability to use & learn various software programs [Hach WIMS, SEMS CMMS, and Utility Cloud].
- Ability to read, interpret, and apply instructions, drawings, and specifications for work assigned.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with superiors, other personnel, and the general public.
- Ability to communicate effectively orally and in writing.
- Must be able to lift or move up to 40 lbs. on a regular basis.
