This full-time position is responsible for the operation and general maintenance of equipment at a 1 MGD advanced wastewater treatment facility. Primary focus will be in laboratory analysis, record keeping, and process control. Secondary focus is assisting with maintenance projects and general facility and grounds maintenance. Activities include, but are not limited to:

- The operation and monitoring of any collection pipelines or distribution network and all associated components.
- Daily inspection and record keeping of plant processes.
- Maintaining communications with project personnel.
- Preventive maintenance activities and data entry and report generation, including data for preparing the Monthly Operating Report.
- Monitor and control assigned tasks to ensure cost-effective service to meet budget, and will serve as an integral team member with the project staff and management.
- Comply with all company Health and Safety procedures and policies.
- Coordinate with plant personnel, ensuring that other facility employees follow established administrative, safety, operating, and maintenance policies.

Qualifications:
