WATER SUPERINTENDENT

The Westford Water Department is seeking applicants for the position of Water Superintendent. The Water Department Superintendent acts as the Chief Executive Officer of the Water Enterprise Fund and as the agent for the Board of Water Commissioners. The Superintendent has ultimate responsibility for treatment and distribution of water throughout the entire system and must comply with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Safe Drinking Water Act and Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) drinking water regulations (310CMR 22.00). The Superintendent is responsible for managing all Water Department staff. The Superintendent is responsible for overall management of all aspects of the Department including budget, operations, state and federal reporting, and serves as liaison for the Department to the Board of Water Commissioners and DEP.

Requires independent thinking and judgment to resolve complex problems related to drinking water treatment and operations and to ensure public safety. Must be available to respond to emergencies at all times. Must have the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, town officials, the business community, State, Regional and Federal officials and the general public. Seeking an individual with excellent organizational and time management abilities along with outstanding interpersonal, verbal, and written communication skills.

The minimum qualification is a Massachusetts Drinking Water Supply Facilities Operator's License, Grade 3 Distribution and Grade 3 Treatment and a minimum of five years (10 years preferred) experience in water systems with three years (five years preferred) in a responsible administrative and/or supervisory role, prefer Degree in Engineering or related field and SCADA experience. The applicant will show a progressively responsible experience in water system management, public works construction and public facility maintenance; and knowledge of federal, state and town laws and regulations related to public water supplies and systems. Salary commensurate with experience. The Town of Westford is an EEO/AA Employer.
