## **POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

Performs any combination of the following tasks pertinent to controlling the operation of the facility.

Operates treatment facility to control flow and processing of wastewater, biosolids, and effluent.

Monitors gages, meters, and control panels. Operates valves and gates, either manually or by remote control starts and stops pumps, engines, and generators to control the treatment process.

This individual is under the supervision of the Superintendent and the Asst. Superintendent performs laboratory duties when required and fills in for maintenance person when required. Must be able to maintain accurate records concerning process control.

Drives a truck on a needed basis. Must be capable of performing rudimentary operational control functions within the facility. Involved with the operation and maintenance of the collection system. Shall be familiar with all the safety equipment used in the department.

- 1.) **License:** Minimum of Massachusetts (Grade 4) Wastewater Treatment Operators License required.
- 2.) **Education:** Highschool or trade school education or equivalent training and experience.

  - B.)** Wastewater Treatment, compost operation, sewer system and pump stations.
