



Wastewater Engineering Technician

The Littleton Electric Light & Water Department is seeking applicants for the newly created position of Wastewater Engineering Technician. The Wastewater Engineering Technician will provide construction oversight of the new, \$30 Million Littleton Common Sewer System that is currently out to bid and will serve as the Chief Operator of this system once constructed.

Position works under the administrative direction of the Superintendent and cooperates with the Operations Manager to apply Department resources towards the operation, maintenance, and construction of the Littleton Sewer System. The successful candidate will be required to participate in the weekly Supervisor On-Call rotation, which requires the ability to respond to after-hours emergencies at any time of day or night for one week out of every five. The Wastewater Engineering Technician must communicate professionally and effectively verbally and in writing.

Minimum desired qualifications include an Associate's degree (Bachelor's preferred) in science, engineering, or management, a Class 5 Massachusetts Wastewater Operators License, and a minimum of 10 years' experience in the wastewater industry, 5 of which have preferably been in the operation of a Suez Membrane Biological Reactor, with some collection system experience as well. Starting salary is between \$85,000 and \$100,000, dependent on qualifications. Benefits include a 4-day work week (Monday through Thursday, 6:30-4:30), enrollment in the Massachusetts Public Pension System, 11 paid holidays per year, 2 weeks' paid vacation per year to start (up to 5 weeks depending upon years of service), 12 sick days per year, and 24 hours of personal time per year.
