Organization

The organizational structure of MWWA includes a President, President-Elect, Treasurer, Secretary, and a four person Board of Directors consisting of the immediate Past President and three Trustees. A full-time Executive Director conducts the day-to-day business of the association.

Committees

MWWA welcomes your participation on any number of our active committees. MWWA is a volunteer organization and thrives on the dedication, commitment, and support of our members.

The **Program Committee** is responsible for scheduling and planning meetings which provide a forum for discussion of current technical, operational, regulatory, and legislative issues. The Program Committee organized the annual Summer Expo and Clambake, a water works tradition which attracts some 1,100 water works professionals. Other membership meetings are scheduled throughout the state to encourage participation of all our members.

The **Education Committee** provides continuing education for water works professionals and awards CEUs. The Committee conducts review seminars for the Massachusetts Operator's Certification Exam as well as other seminars and workshops to provide practical hands-on experience and training.

The **Legislative Committee** tracks the legislation that impacts the water works industry. The Committee is our industry's vehicle for keeping legislature and the Commonwealth's regulatory agencies informed of the concerns of water purveyors and their customers.

The **Technical Advisory Committee** evaluates the impacts of proposed regulations on the industry from a scientific perspective.

The **Membership and Public Relations Committees** work together to promote "Water Works Pride" while conveying the opportunities of membership in MWWA and enhancing the image of the association.

The **Sponsorship Committee** manages MWWA's annual Sponsorship Program which provides the necessary funding for the membership meetings and special events that take place throughout the year.

The **Historical Committee** strives to protect our future by preserving and protecting out past water works memorabilia of historical significance.
